Praise the Lord! We are delighted to announce that COCM, UK has just accepted Rev. William Hu and Mrs. Emily Hu as missionaries. They have been serving in the Danbury Chinese Alliance Church in Connecticut since 2006. Last April, they went to COCM, UK headquarters to serve at the Easter Mandarin camp. At first, they worried about possible generation gap. But after interacting with many Chinese students in the camp, they were amazed by the acceptance they received. One sister even thanked the Lord for letting her meet Rev. Hu, whom she felt was like a father to her! More importantly, Pastor and Mrs. Hu witnessed the students' enthusiasm to learn God's Word. After the camp, COCM General Director Rev. Henry Lu shared the needs in the UK with camp counselors. After

much prayer and searching for calling from God, Pastor and Mrs. Hu was convinced by the Holy Spirit to serve in the UK. They plan to join COCM ministry and move to the UK this October. Therefore we would like to ask you to remember them in your prayers. Also included in this letter are their testimonies. In his annual report published in the recent issue of *Link*, Rev, Lu mentioned that *"In the coming year, COCM will continue to focus on ministering to mainland Chinese students, new immi-grants and the local language speaking ethnic Chinese in the UK and Continental Europe. We will give our best effort to coordinate our ministries in evangelizing the Chinese in Europe, equipping them to grow in Christ and encouraging them to participate in mission work. COCM will strategically train up a new generation of Christian leaders prepared to join the mission force to advance God's kingdom."*
